Church Campus Report: Terry O'Reilly/ Jack Nickol

The Two Lights along the driveway should be completed within the next several weeks. The cost of the project may be less than forecasted.

A new project to cut the weeds beyond the rear fence is being estimated. This would give a storage area for the parade float and other equipment. The project would include removal of all bushes and trees cut as well as other debris.

Old Business

The Pancake Breakfast: Art Szymanski is all set for January 18th. Members have signed up for both shifts

Good Shepherd shirts: With the illness of Frank Townsend, Robert Meise will work with Frank and Ray DeShano to get the information from Frank and forward it to Dave. We stressed the urgency to get the shirts on order by March 15 so they could be available for the parish picnic on April 26. Father Bob said he would like to have a new logo for the 50 anniversary of the parish and Dave will work with him as the representative to the Parish Council.

Advent Spiritual Program: The next meeting is Wednesday January 21. This program will run every other Wednesday after the 9:00 am mass and all are encouraged to attend these wonderful programs.

New Business:

2014 Accomplishments and plans for 2015: Attached are the accomplishments of 2014. The Men's Club can be very proud of the accomplishments.

Also attached are the list of proposed activities for 2015 including the assigned chairmen for the activity. After discussion it was decided to drop one of the Fish Fries scheduled for March 13th. Future activities will be added as projects come up. A motion was made by Ray DeShano and seconded by Jerry O’Haire to drop the third fish fry. The cost of the fish fry for this year will be raised to \$10 per person.

2015 Budget plan: Bill Peters presented a summary of income projection and expenses for the major fund raising projects during the upcoming year. This model will be used to track the actual budget for the year.

Pancake Breakfast for February 15, 2015: Dave McKloskey will chair this breakfast.

Open Discussion:

Ron Lalli presented two ideas for improvement of the parish campus. 1) For safety reasons, remove the tire stop in front of the life center second door and paint the walk area with blue stripes as the other entrance. 2) Put a roof over the deck on the Rectory. Both suggestions will be discussed with Father for future consideration.

Terry O’Reilly presented a proposal to purchase two deep fryers for the kitchen so that we can cook the fish and fries more efficiently in the upcoming fish fries. The proposal would cost approximately \$1,600 for both fryers. After discussion a motion to fund this project was made by Ed Zeasar and seconded by Robert Meise. The motion was approved. Terry also proposed a new fund raiser of a pulled pork dinner to be held in the May time frame. More details will be presented at the next meeting

Ed Zeasar presented the purpose of the evangelization committee and encouraged any member to see him about how they can help bring back lapsed Catholics to the fold.

The next meeting will be February 11, 2015.
