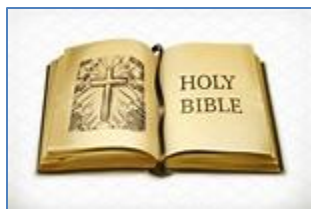

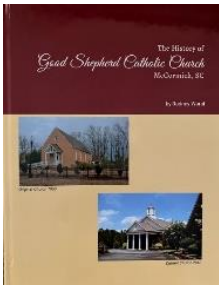

2024 – 2025 Good Shepherd Budget

The Finance Council has completed the 2024 – 2025 budget. The current 2023- 2024 budget year ending June 30, 2024, required the annual contributions to meet expenses to be \$225,531.00. It is estimated that we will exceed that amount by \$100,000.00. Based on our assessments and adjustments to revenue and operating expenses, the 2024 – 2025 budget beginning July 1, 2024, will require contributions to meet the projected operating expenses to be \$5,319.00 per week. The contribution increase will cover the ongoing Administrative, Church, Parish Life Center, Rectory and maintenance expenses. This budget has been submitted to the Diocese of Charleston. Ken Woodburn, Finance Council Chairman.
