The Body and Blood of Christ B 2024

All the dogmas are very difficult to understand. The dogma of Trinity, immaculate conception, assumption, the dogma of the Body and Blood of our Lord and the real presence... Even though we do not understand what we believe. It is not because of our merit but God is gracious enough to give us the grace to believe.

The origin of Today's Feast of Corpus Christi goes back to the high Middle Ages. It is a moment to reflect on the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist, this greatest of sacraments and a beloved truth of our faith. In Europe, it is a feast often marked by outdoor celebrations. About 35 years ago, it was combined with the feast of the precious Blood. So today we celebrate the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ.

Our readings today look at three different dimensions of the Mass: power, presence, and promise. The letter to the Hebrews today takes us back to the great Temple sacrifices in Jerusalem to show us the power of the Mass. Our Gospel reading takes us to the Last Supper to show the real and continuing presence of Christ among us in the Eucharist. Today's reading from the Book of Exodus takes us to the mountain of the covenant to show that the Eucharist is the place where the promise of God and the promise of His people still come together. Power, presence, and promise.

First, the power of the Mass and a brief trip to the Jerusalem Temple. The letter to the Hebrews gives us an idea of Temple liturgy on the Day of Atonement and the ritual slaying of bulls and goats. In fact, the Temple back then had a whole array of sacrifices. The Temple was a slaughterhouse with heaps of carcasses and rivers of blood flashing and splashing. There were sacrifices to atone, to thank, to adore, and to make peace, to make petition. There was a whole array of sacrifices, all striving, straining, trying, and yearning to achieve what Jesus did on Calvary, the perfect, complete sacrifice.

The Mass is the true sacrifice and all the bloody rituals in the Old Testament were the early symbols foreshadowing what Christ would do. The Mass makes present Christ's powerful, unique Calvary sacrifice. The Mass makes the present the single, all-powerful sacrifice of Christ with two differences. Now the pain, the crowds, the blood, the agony are gone. It is an unbloody sacrifice. Secondly, we can add our prayers to Christ's. We can fuse our petitions, big and small, to the great powerful Calvary sacrifice of Christ. That is the power of the Mass.

In today's Gospel reading, we go from Jerusalem Temple to the Last Supper. Jesus says, "This is my Body, this is my Blood." Christ is present among us in many ways but here in the Eucharist, the Lord Jesus is present fully, substantially and in an unobstructed way. Sometimes people say, we can see Christ in our neighbor. But that is often difficult to do. Usually, people's personalities present a lot of interference. But in the Eucharist, the Lord is present without obstruction. That is the significance of the red lamp that we have beside the tabernacle, the real presence. When we come to church, we don't have to hope that Christ will be here. He is! His presence does not depend on our mood, the degree of faith or whether we are in a state of grace. Christ is truly here. The Eucharist is the place of presence. And Christ will abide with us until the end of time. Who knows what changes will occur in the Church over the next thousand years? But a thousand years from now, in every Catholic Church there will always be a tabernacle. It is the abiding presence of Christ in all our joys and sorrows, with us on our life's journey like the ark that traveled with the Israelites wherever they went. The Eucharist is the sacrament of Christ's presence. Finally, the reading from the Book of Exodus takes us to the holy mountain and the Lord's promise to be with His people and their promise to be faithful to His law. "We will do everything the Lord has told us." The Mass is the place of promise. When we receive Holy Communion worthily, we are promised that we will be one with the Lord

The Eucharist is also the place of our promise to be faithful, to be loyal to Christ and to His Church, to be in communion with the Church. When we receive Holy Communion, we say "Amen," we are not only making an affirmation of faith (I believe) but also making a promise to follow Christ faithfully. The Mass is the place of promise, God's promise to us of future glory, our promise of fidelity.

someday, face to face. It is a pledge of future glory as St. Thomas Aquinas wrote.

Power, Presence and Promise: It is important that we keep the Mass holy. It is the Temple of a powerful sacrifice, of table of unity around the real presence of Christ and our mountain of promise of fidelity to Christ and His Church.
